Dear friends,

We have nearly finished our Lenten journey of 40 days. Tonight, we gather for our Maundy Thursday worship with Communion at 7 p.m. We will recall the Last Supper with Christ and his disciples and when our Lord humbled himself and washed his disciples' feet. Do you remember how Peter responds? In John 13, he says, "You will never wash my feet!" Jesus answers, "Unless I wash you, you have no share with me." Peter then has a change of heart: "Lord, not my feet only but also my hands and my head!"

We call the Thursday before Easter Holy Thursday or "Maundy" Thursday from the Latin *mandatum*, or commandment, for following the meal and the foot washing, Jesus will say, "I give you a new *commandment*, that you love one another. Just as I have loved you, you also should love one another. By this everyone will know that you are my disciples, if you have love for one another."





On Sunday, we will gather for Easter worship at 10:20 a.m. in our sanctuary, with extended gathering music. The service of Word and Sacrament will include a message for the children and members sharing their musical gifts throughout the service, along with Alice Hoover playing organ. With joy and gladness, we welcome our new life, another new beginning with our Redeemer, as the Apostle Paul tells us, "forgetting what lies behind and straining forward to what lies ahead."

He is risen! He is risen, indeed! Alleluia! Amen.
