Dear friends,

We will be celebrating our Savior with palms this Sunday as we remember our Lord's final entry into Jerusalem. Palm Sunday marks the beginning of Holy Week. We continue our Lenten journey to the cross with our Maundy Thursday worship next Thursday at 7:30 p.m. and our glorious Easter worship on Sunday, April 17.

The word "Hosanna" comes up repeatedly in our Palm Sunday worship - in our music and in our Scripture readings. The people lay down their cloaks in the road and shout "Hosanna" - a Hebrew word meaning "Save us!" - as Jesus passes by on a borrowed colt of a donkey. The people celebrating Jesus don't understand, yet, that Christ's kingdom is not of this world. All of this takes place to show how Christ is the fulfillment of the prophecy of Zechariah 9:9:

*Rejoice greatly, Daughter Zion!  
Shout, Daughter Jerusalem!  
See, your king comes to you,  
righteous and victorious,  
lowly and riding on a donkey,  
on a colt, the foal of a donkey.*

Increasing our joy this Sunday will be the celebration of the sacrament of Baptism for Betty Salvage and Jewell Opachick, the daughter of Matt and Erica Opachick.

I look forward to making more sweet memories with my beloved flock in my final days with you. May we be comforted by the many promises in God's Word and the faithfulness of our Lord in the past. You will be forever in my heart.




- 9:00 a.m. All Church Easter Breakfast in the parlor followed by an Easter Egg Hunt for children
