Greetings, dear friends,

We gather tonight for our Maundy Thursday worship with Communion in the chapel at 7:30 p.m. The intimate service is named for the Latin word for command: *mandatum*. In this service, we will remember the Passover meal and when Jesus washed the feet of his disciples, as Peter protested, "You will never wash my feet!" Jesus will tell his disciples that his hour has come and one of them will betray him. He has a new command for them to follow, a command that is for you and me and all Christ's followers in every time and place.

*I give you a new commandment, that you love one another. Just as I have loved you, you also should love one another. By this everyone will know that you are my disciples, if you have love for one another. (John 13:34-35)*

After Communion, we move into the "Service of the Shadows," with readings and music that tell the story of Christ's betrayal and suffering. The service ends in quiet darkness.

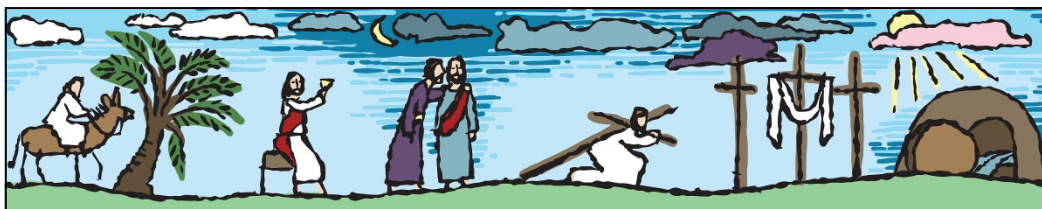
Then, on Sunday, we will gather for the joyous celebration of the resurrection of our Savior and the promise of our new life in Jesus Christ. The Chancel and Cherub choirs will sing, as will a choir of children and youth. The extended prelude will include members sharing their musical gifts. We will celebrate Communion and Baptism.

Come early on Easter to enjoy breakfast at 9 a.m. followed by an Easter egg hunt for the children.

Blessings of peace and joy be with you throughout Holy Week—from the cross to the grave and to Mary's discovery of the empty tomb on the first day.
